- **10:00 am – 2:00 pm City's Big Truck and Equipment Show**  
The City is hosting their annual heavy equipment show in front of city hall that will also highlight antique equipment used in bygone days to maintain our city infrastructure.
- **10:30 am: Time Capsule Opening**  
Be ready to open the time capsule in front of City Hall to see what hidden treasures have been buried for 50 years. Contents of the time capsule will be on display for the public at city hall throughout the event, along with other artifacts on loan from local residents.
- **11:00 am – 2:00 pm: 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Art and Artifacts Fair**
