

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 26. STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, BY ADDING SEC. 26-56. LIVABLE STREETS ADVISORY BOARD ESTABLISHED; DUTIES, FOR THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the Lee's Summit 360° Charting Tomorrow Strategic Plan as a guideline and list of ideal goals that the City and its partners would like to accomplish over the next 10-15 years; and,

WHEREAS, the Lee's Summit 360° Charting Tomorrow Strategic Plan, Transportation Key Performance Area, Goal 2, provides for the creation of a Complete Streets Advisory Committee, being the same as a Livable Streets Advisory Board; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 10-17, a resolution establishing the livable streets policy for the City of Lee's Summit and such resolution, section seven, describes the City's intent to adopt an ordinance which would create a Livable Streets Advisory Board for the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MISSOURI, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Division I, Generally, of Article II. Public Improvements, in Chapter 26. Streets, sidewalks and other public places, in the Code of Ordinances for the City of Lee's Summit, Missouri, is hereby amended by the addition of Section 26-56 as follows:

Sec. 26-56. – Livable Streets Advisory Board established; duties.

- A. The Livable Streets Advisory Board ("Board") is hereby established.
1. The Board shall consist of eleven (11) citizen members, appointed by the Mayor with advice and consent of a majority of the Council.
 2. One member of the Council shall serve as liaison, without voting rights, appointed by the Mayor Pro-Tem with the advice and consent of a majority of the Council.
 3. One member of the City Staff shall serve as liaison, without voting rights, designated by the City Manager.
 4. Citizen members shall serve three-year terms, which shall be staggered.
 5. The Board shall elect a Chair and Vice-Chair annually following the annual appointments to the Board. Citizen Board members shall serve without compensation.
 6. Board meetings shall be open to the public and shall be conducted pursuant to Missouri Sunshine Law; RSMo 610.010 et seq. Robert's Rules of Order shall govern procedural matters of the Board.
 7. The Board may establish a Section 501C-3 Corporation for the purpose of not-for-profit fund raising to assist in duties of the Board.
- B. The Board shall perform the following duties:

1. Advise the City Council on methods and procedures to accomplish the guiding principles of livable streets described in City of Lee's Summit Resolution 10-17.
2. Review and evaluate the application and implementation of the livable streets policy described in Resolution 10-17.
3. Upon request of the City Council or City Manager, assist with long-range and ongoing planning efforts that may be related to livable streets.
4. Promote the livable streets concept throughout the community and greater metropolitan area.
5. Educate the public regarding safe bicycling, walking and driving, applicable traffic laws, and the use of roads for multiple travel modes.
6. Encourage citizens to walk, bike and take public transportation.
7. Participate in programs that designate, reward or recognize the City's support, progress and accomplishments regarding livable streets.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption, and approval by the Mayor.
